Transportation

The closest airport to the city of Nicosia is the **Larnaca International Airport**, which is one of the two **legal** points of entry into the Republic of Cyprus (along with the Paphos International Airport).

Entry into the territory of the Republic of Cyprus via any other airport in which the Government of the Republic does not exercise effective control (Turkish occupied areas) is illegal. Cyprus is NOT a member of the Schengen area, so you would need an EU ID or a passport to get into the country.

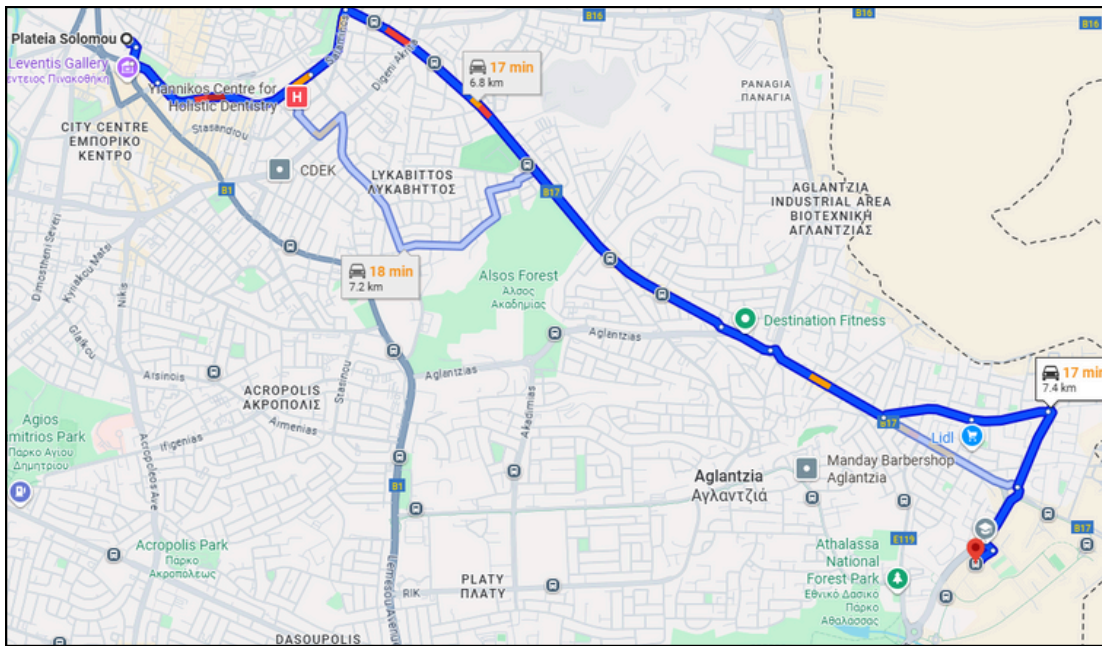

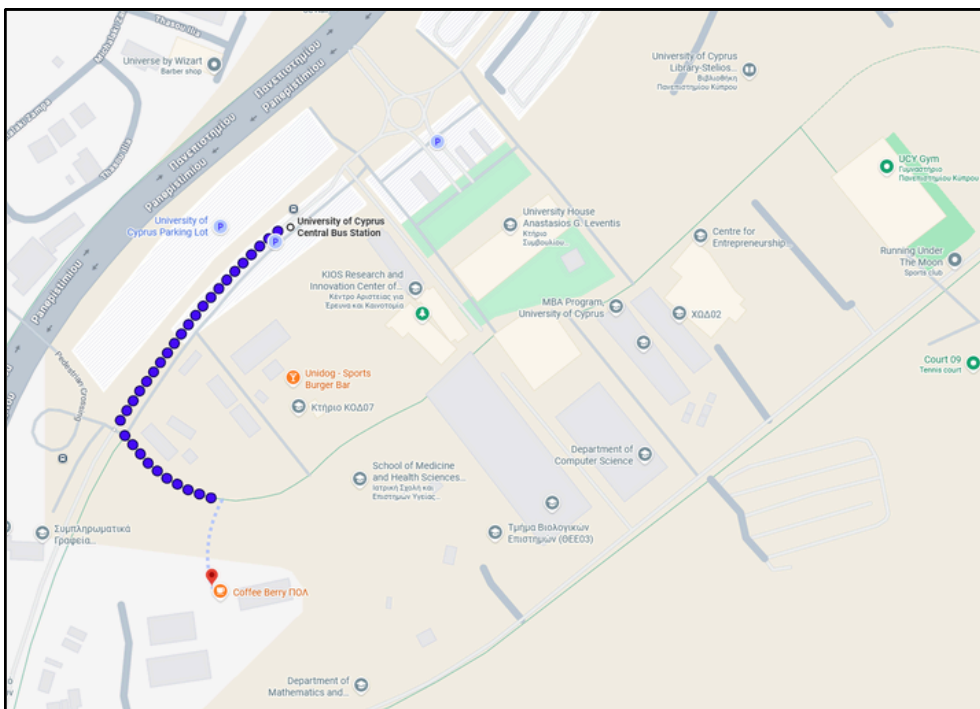

Note: In Cyprus, the standard electrical sockets are of Type G, which is the same as those used in the UK. These sockets have three rectangular pins in a triangular pattern. Therefore, visitors from countries that do not use Type G sockets will need an adapter to plug in their devices.

About Nicosia

Nicosia is the capital and largest city of the Republic of Cyprus, a sophisticated and cosmopolitan place, rich in history and culture, combining its historic past with the amenities of a modern city. It has a number of museums and art galleries, Byzantine churches and a number of mediaeval and neo-classical buildings while the narrow streets retain the romantic atmosphere of the past.

Nicosia enjoys a Mediterranean climate with long dry summers from mid-May to mid-October and mild winters from December to February, which are separated by short autumn and spring seasons. In March, the average temperature ranges from 19-20 °C during the day to 7-10 °C during the night in Nicosia. See [Cyprus Weather](#) for more details.
