## UCY offers expertise on water management

The University of Cyprus and Ministry of Agriculture, Natural Resources and the Environment have entered into an agreement to cooperate on better water management.

The cooperation aims at further developing scientific and technological knowledge to better understand and handle specific problems related to the monitoring and management of water sources and best maintaining their quality.
